Metrics studies have an important role in understanding the growth of a discipline and assist in designing national policies for implementation and improving. This study is a scientometric study to examining the research contribution of Asaam Agricultural University, the one and only agricultural university of North-East India. The study period has been choosen from 2000 to 2015 and total of 677 records were retrieved from Web of Science. The average output of the organization is 42 publications per year; the maximum is 66 items in 2003 and the minimum is 21 items in the year 2010.
