Methods to Improve Reading Skills

- Practicing reading for at least 15 to 30 minutes a day, every day, will make a big difference.
- Providing opportunities for students during class hours for reading a particular passage or any lesson as a whole, as a practice to check the pronunciation, modulation, stress, pace, intonation, articulation etc.
- Students should be encouraged to read new passages which are not familiar for them as this would also help to improve vocabulary.
- Black-boards and flash cards may be used to make the learner read, pronounce and understand the word. This also helps in building vocabulary and familiarizes the words.
- Learners can be asked to read out loud as it involves the text in two ways: the eyes look at the words, and ears, listen to them. It is also a good method to practice pronunciation.
- Skills such as silent reading, scanning and skimming should be introduced to students as it would be of great help for students in the tertiary level of education. The mechanisms and advantages of developing these skills should be explained to the students in detail.
- Reading of magazines, journals, newspaper, stories, etc., by students should be encouraged as exposure to different writing styles would help to attain proficiency in English.
- Practice exercises for reading directions, phone directories, job advertisements, official notices, bus and train time-tables, business letters etc., can be carried out in class.
- Motivating students to read lessons every day in the classroom and at home and summarizing the same has dual purposes. This can help improve reading skill and also make the student become proficient academically.
- Learners should be made to read the sentences with missing words and fill the blanks with the word they feel is most appropriate based on the rest of the sentence. This activity not only improves reading comprehension, but will train students to use context to learn new vocabulary words.

- Frequent visits to the library will help the learner to improve library skills so that they can develop habit of reading.
- The reading comprehension exercises provided must be must be arranged from simple to complex or familiar to unfamiliar text to help in the improvement of fluency.
- Students should be taught about specific reading types such as intensive and extensive reading and their utilization in their daily lives.
- Re- reading is advisable as it helps to catch up on the less familiar and new words present in the material and gain sense out of it.

Reading is given importance in any language as it leads to understanding. Enhancing reading skills simultaneously enhances language, vocabulary, communication, fluency, creativity, thought process, interpretation skills and ability to critically analyze situations and things.
